

£2.1 Million for injury to a wrestler against his (National Level) Coach's Insurance

In May 2002 a landmark decision in an Australian court led to an award of AUD\$5.7million (£2.1m) for injury to a wrestler against his (national level) coach's insurance. The court ruled that the wrestler's irreversible spinal injury caused during a training bout was a result of improper supervision. This is expected to set an international precedent for future actions in the Courts and it would be naïve to think that it couldn't happen in the United Kingdom.
